On the adoption of the Table of Ranks

WHEREAS efficient governance requires standardization of the state ranks, and *HAVING IN MIND* that the existing system is in a need of serious amending, is hereby decreed the following:

1. The Table of Ranks, drafted by the Ministry of State Security and followed in Appendix I, is to be adopted as an official list of ranks and positions in the military, government and court of Lostisland;
2. The Decree comes into force on the day of signing.

Appendix I. The Table of Ranks of the Federal Republic of Lostisland

<u>Class</u>	<u>Civil ranks</u>	<u>Military ranks</u>
<u>1</u>	Actual Privy Councilor <i>(highest civil ministerial rank)</i>	Field marshal general (Army) Field marshal general (Navy) <i>(highest military ranks, assigned for special merits and for seniority)</i>
<u>2</u>	Civil Secretary, State Councilor <i>(main civil ministerial rank)</i>	Ober Commissary (Army) Captain at Sea (Navy) <i>(main military ministerial rank, corresponds the offices of Minister of Defense, Commander of the Forces of National Security, Navy; assigned for special merits)</i>
<u>3</u>	Actual Civil Councilor <i>(civil ministerial rank, corresponds the offices of minister and deputy minister of civilian departments)</i>	Brigade Commissary (Army) Frigate Captain (Navy) <i>(military ministerial rank recommended for primary assignment, corresponds the offices of minister and deputy minister of power departments)</i>
<u>4</u>	Civil Councilor <i>(civil rank of an advisor to minister and ministry official, ambassador, consul, local judge)</i>	Chamber Junker (Army) Senior Midshipmen (Navy) <i>(military rank, assigned to adjutants of power department ministers, military specialists and commanders of territorial subdivisions of special services and the Navy)</i>
<u>5</u>	College Secretary <i>(civil rank of an assistant to ambassador, consul)</i>	Junker (Army) Midshipman (Navy) <i>(initial military rank of citizens beginning a professional military career)</i>

Military ranks below the Table of Ranks: Private (Army), Seaman (Navy)
(assigned at war time in case of general mobilization)

1. Civil and military officers of 2 – 4 ranks are appointed directly by Presidential Decree, or on the proposal of the superiors and by Presidential Decree.
2. Civil and military officers of the 1st rank are appointed by Presidential Decree.
3. Civil and military officers of 5th rank are appointed by Presidential Decree or by decrees of the Ministers.
4. Presidential Decree may revoke any appointment.
