Decree

19/2015 March 20, 2015

On the adoption of the Table of Ranks

WHEREAS efficient governance requires standardization of the state ranks, and HAVING IN MIND that the existing system is in a need of serious amending, is hereby decreed the following:

- 1. The Table of Ranks, drafted by the Ministry of State Security and followed in Appendix I, is to be adopted as an official list of ranks and positions in the military, government and court of Lostisland;
- 2. The Decree comes into force on the day of signing.

Military ranks below the Table of Ranks: Private (Army), Seaman (Navy) (assigned at war time in case of general mobilization)

- 1. Civil and military officers of 2-4 ranks are appointed directly by Presidential Decree, or on the proposal of the superiors and by Presidential Decree.
- Civil and military officers of the 1st rank are appointed by Presidential Decree.
 Civil and military officers of 5th rank are appointed by Presidential Decree or by decrees of the Ministers.
- 4. Presidential Decree may revoke any appointment.
