**PRESIDENTIAL DECREE
1/2021**

On the establishment and issuance of the Presidential Citation of Merit

Whereas it is in the interest of the Federal Republic to have a mechanism for awarding distinguished foreigners,

1. The Presidential Citation of Merit shall be hereby established as a national award of the Federal Republic of Lostisland conferred by the President of Lostisland upon foreign Heads of State, senior officials, or other accomplished individuals.
2. The recipients of the Presidential Citation of Merit shall be entitled to the postnominals **PCML** (Presidential Citation of Merit of Lostisland).
3. A certificate confirming the conferral of the Presidential Citation of Merit shall be issued and shipped to the recipients free of charge.
4. The following individuals shall be inducted as the first recipients of the Presidential Citation of Merit:
 - a. H.M. Queen Carolyn I of Ladonia: in recognition of her commitment to excellence in nation-building, and for her outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.
 - b. H.E. Foreign Minister Thomas Chepaitis of the Republic of Užupis: in recognition of his commitment to excellence in nation-building, cross-culture dialogue, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.
 - c. H.I.M. Emperor Jonathan I of Austenasia: in recognition of his commitment to historical and encyclopedic research, promotion of Roman culture, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.
 - d. H.I.M. Emperor Eric Lis of Aerica: in recognition of his commitment to defending human rights, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.

- e. H.E. Vice President Stephen Luke of the Commonwealth of Dracul: in recognition of his commitment to excellence in nation-building, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.
- f. H.R.H. Grand Duke Nicholas of Flandrensis: in recognition of his commitment to environmentalism, fighting climate change, the preservation of Antarctica as a unique natural reserve, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.
- g. H.I.&R.A.M. Emperor Oscar I of Karnia-Ruthenia: in recognition of his commitment to excellence in nation-building, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.
- h. H.R.H. Grand Duke Travis of Westarctica: in recognition of his commitment to environmentalism, fighting climate change, the preservation of Antarctica as a unique natural reserve, and for his outstanding work dedicated to securing global peace and promoting diplomacy in the community of small nations.

Further inductments shall be at the discretion of the President.
