

Memorandum of Understanding

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is made and entered into as of *5 October 2023* by and between:

The Federal Republic of Lostisland, a global sovereignty and an independent social and cultural organisation under international law based on the ideals of freedom and democracy, operating in the form of a nation-state. Lostisland doesn't claim to be a sovereign state or challenge the sovereign territory of any state but rather defines itself as a cultural and social project. (hereinafter referred to as "*Lostisland*").

Climate Justice Advocacy, Kampala-Uganda, a grassroots movement that seeks to ensure that all people have the opportunity to live in a healthy and sustainable environment. The organization raises public awareness of the negative impacts of climate change on vulnerable and marginalized groups, empowers these groups to take lead action in the fight against climate change, and carries out grassroots research to support this goal. (hereinafter referred to as "*Climate Justice Advocacy*").

Recitals

Lostisland and *Climate Justice Advocacy* (hereinafter referred to as the "*Parties*") are interested in partnering to advance their shared goals of climate action. The *Parties* are committed to climate action and environmental justice. They believe that collaboration is essential to addressing the climate crisis and ensuring a just and sustainable future for all. The *Parties* believe that collaboration is essential to addressing the climate crisis. They are committed to working together to share knowledge, resources, and expertise to advance climate action and environmental justice.

1. Purpose

The purpose of this MoU is to establish a framework of cooperation to achieve the *Parties* shared goals.

2. Roles and Responsibilities

Lostisland agrees to:

- A. Provide technical support, specifically Zoom Hosting, for *Climate Justice Advocacy's* bi-monthly webinars.

Climate Justice Advocacy agrees to:

- A. Support *Lostisland* with knowledge, research, and analysis related to climate justice issues.
- B. Support the development and implementation of *Lostisland's* policies and initiatives pertaining to youth engagement in climate action.

Obligations:

Climate Justice Advocacy agrees to provide *Lostisland* with the date and time of its bi-monthly webinars at least seven (7) days in advance.

3. Intellectual Property:

All intellectual property created by either *Party* in connection with this MoU will remain the property of the creating *Party*. However, the *Parties* grant each other a non-exclusive, royalty-free license to use such intellectual property for the purposes of this MoU.

4. Confidentiality:

The *Parties* agree to keep confidential all information shared between them in connection with this MoU, except as required by applicable law.

5. Dispute Resolution:

Any disputes arising from this MoU will be resolved through amicable negotiation. If the *Parties* cannot resolve a dispute through negotiation, it will be submitted to binding arbitration in accordance with the rules of the applicable arbitration association.

6. Term and Termination:

This MoU will commence on the effective date and remain in effect for one (1) year. Either *Party* may terminate this MoU at any time by providing fifteen (15) days' written notice to the other *Party*.
